#### Course

- Five-week, facilitated, fully online course
- To prepare AUC instructors to teach online and blended
- To make sure that instructors are prepared for the substantial differences between teaching online and in a classroom.
- Teachers experience being an online student
- Requirement before facilitating online/blended courses

#### Audience

- Part-time instructors
- Professionals not academics
- Participating in the school's newly launched blended initiative
- Lack of experience with online and blended learning.
- Concerned about level of interaction with students

## Challenges

- Lack of communication between leadership and instructors
- Lack of communication between instructor and students
- Lack of interaction between participants in the course
- Students' expectations in blended courses
- Instructors' motivation to teach in this format
- Instructor confidence in this delivery method

#### Challenges for instructional designers

- Technical difficulties with platform
- Time frame adjustments
- Adjusting material to audience knowledge level & digital literacy

### Course format

#### Original

- 3 weeks
- 6 modules
  - 1st, 3rd, 5th were F2F
- Blended format of delivery
- No 'Getting Started' module time
- Limited hands on -technical- homework/activities
- Limited peer feedback activities
- Increased reliance on F2F classes

#### Adjusted

- 5 weeks
- 5 modules
- Fully online
- 1 week 'Getting Started' module time
- Same content, different emphasis
  - Removed 'Rubrics' module
  - Combined 'Transitions & Flow' with 'Facilitating Interaction'
- Added assignments
  - Welcome video
  - Learning Journal
  - Peer feedback
- Edited material for length and audience
