DO NOT HAVE A PROGRAM

- The program may cover Freshmen, Seniors and on demand Help-Desk support
- Only one case reported IL program embedded in the curriculum, with scaffolded content per academic year

"We have invited faculty sometimes to book for session but they do not. Only one or two may come with a challenge. For this reason we have always referred them to register for INASP moodle course training which come up two times in a year. But that has not yielded any result."









IL problems





"Lack of identification and acceptance of IL program and the Librarians who are to teach. Only faculty are identified as people who can teach. Meanwhile there is no faculty with Library or IL training/qualification."

"Lack of acknowledgment by the institution of the librarians' role as teachers; almost non-existent chance for the librarians to have a say into academic matters"

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Elements taught by a librarian









- More time for planning/preparation
- Deeper integration for better results
- More sessions of IL teaching (in more courses in some cases)
- More time for follow up
