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During the pandemic, we at the Anatolia College Libraries enriched our website pages with content in a user-friendly way.

- Our goal was to put together useful content in user friendly libguides and make the teacher and student experience, as easy as possible, during this time.
- We designed the guides with a student-centered approach.
- The content is frequently updated and most of it is openly available on our website.
- Firstly, we shared open scholarly content (which publishers decided to offer for free) to our users.
- Our guide with the most views is the "StaySafe Resources..." Guide with 7,523 views (including HS and Elementary students)
- Second most viewed is our "Teaching & Learning Guide" with 3,862 views

- And last, our third most viewed guide is "How to access our online library" with 1,879 views.
- There were 10 new library guides created from all Anatolia College Libraries (March 2020- April 2021), out of which 8 were created by the Bissell Librarians and are focused on teaching and learning






### Total Views on New Guides (2020-2021)
