Embedding critical digital literacies in HE

- Engaging with ethics, power structures & inequalities
- Collaborative across disciplines, functions, institutions, education levels, etc.
- Partnership & peer-to-peer learning (Student-Faculty-Staff)
- Contextualised (situated in local contexts)
- Strategic use of openness (to find, share, teach, assess...)
- Integrated in the curriculum
- Embedded in policy, strategy & culture

4 Rounds of activity...

Pre-Round 1 [4-5 min total]	 Begin with a short round of introductions Identify 1 person as Notetaker (take brief notes on these slides) Identify 1 person as Timekeeper (timing for each Round)
Round 1. SHARING [1 min per person]	Each person shares what they are thinking, feeling or doing about this question [then pass to next person]
Round 2. SHARING AGAIN [1 min per person]	Each person shares their thoughts and feelings, after having listened to everybody [then pass to next person]
Round 3. CONVERSATION [4-5 min total]	Open conversation, amongst all
Round 4. TAKEAWAYS [1 min per person]	Each person shares their "takeaways" [then pass to next person]
