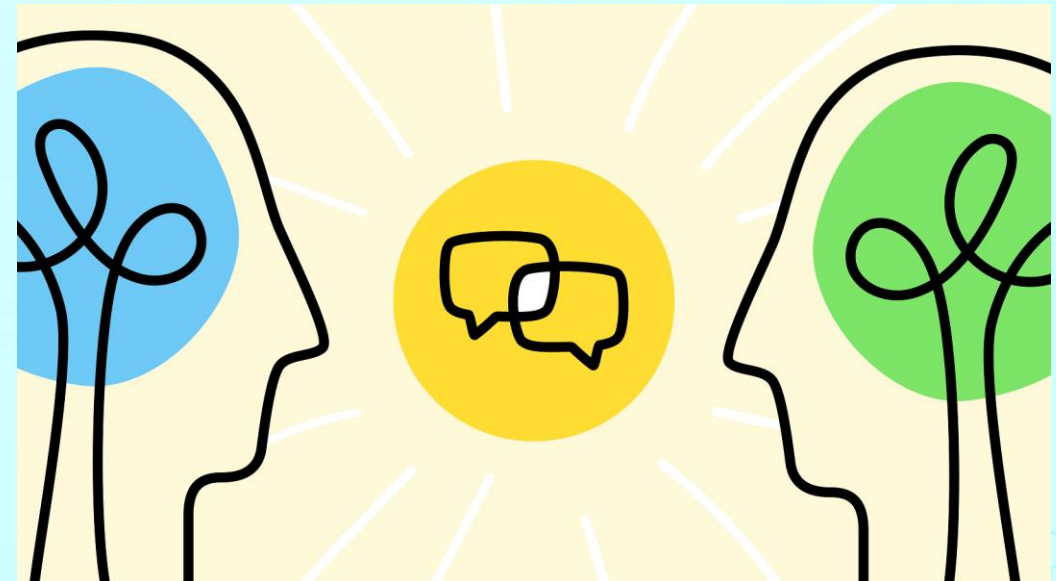

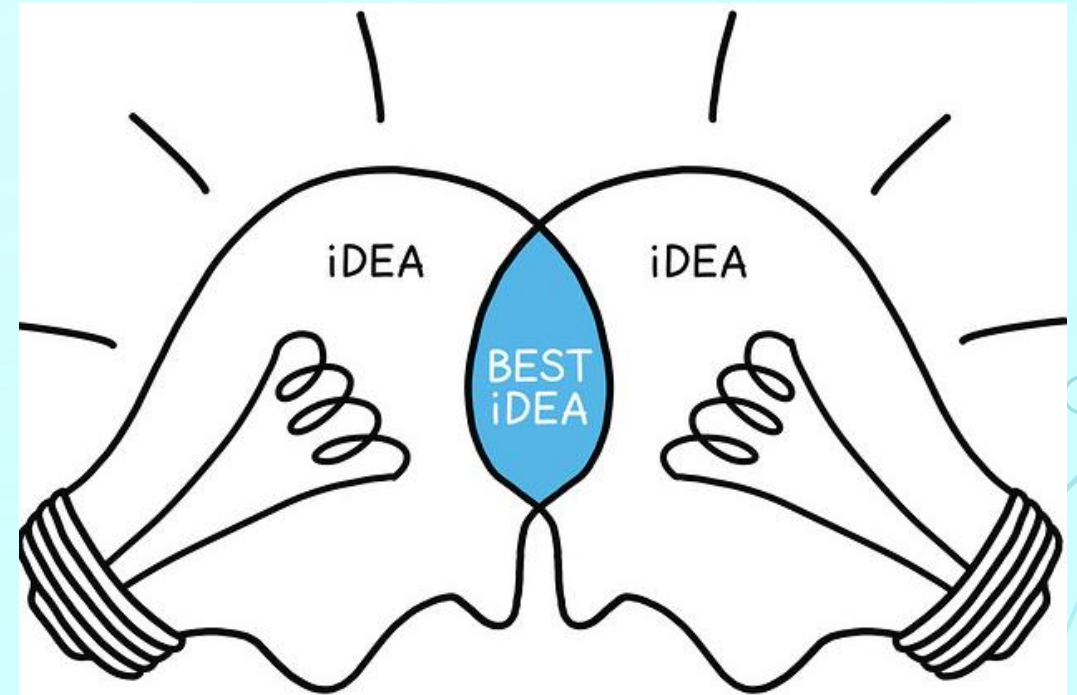


# Collaborations

- Allow institutions
  - to respond to challenges efficiently
  - to maintain the efficacy of support systems
- Changing conditions related to synchronous and asynchronous instruction create
  - continued need to respond to increased demand for services

# Collaboration Best Practices

- Effective collaborations across institutional constituents
  - Shared Principles and Values
  - Development of Authentic Relationships



# Parameters of Effective Collaboration

- Clear goal setting and process protocols
- Open-minded, transparent and honest communication
- Flexibility and adaptability
- Meeting within an environment of trust and respect
- Constructively critical feedback
- Critical reflection cycles
- Alertness to developments and reciprocity
- Relational accountability
- No 'I' in team but no groupthink either

# During Campus Closure: Remote Instruction Tips

- TLC organized Informal monthly gatherings (2020-21: 5 Sessions)
- offered instructors the opportunity
  - to share tips and concerns
  - to resolve common tech issues
  - to acquire new knowledge
- Sessions focus:
  - features of *MS Teams*
  - how to create instructional videos (Panopto, TinyTake)
  - how to use interactivity tools, such as Padlet and Edpuzzle
  - HTML editor

# Since Fall 2021: Ed Tips (6 Sessions)

- Assistance with the pedagogy of remote instruction
- New tools to encourage use of technology in f2f classes
- Focus mostly on tools and apps which increase student engagement
  - MindMeister, Vocaroo, and Sli.do
  - Use of QR codes
  - Image editing
  - Easy screenshot
