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## HOW TO PRODUCE A PODCAST :: Narrative Audio Storytelling

- Background research
- Pitch story ideas
  - Create a focus statement: "Someone does something, because ... , but ..."
- Recording interviews
  - Recording devices
  - Placement of the microphone / recording device
  - Listen
    - Don't interrupt
    - Use non-verbal cues when the interviewee is responding
- Scriptwriting
  - Story structure
- Delivery/Narration
  - Practice reading out loud: books, newspaper articles, etc.
- Audio editing
  - Audacity
  - Garageband
  - Adobe Audition
- Use of music and nat sound
  - Free music resource: Jamendo
  - Gather your own nat sound

## HOW TO ASSESS A PODCAST

- Writing
  - Strength of the writing
  - Ability to tell a story
  - Beginning, middle and end
- Delivery/narration
  - Understandable
  - Believable
  - Naturally conversational
- Editing
  - Clean edit
  - Flow of the editing
  - Even levels
